We will not conform to the world's expectations of a church, but transform the world.

This is no easy road, but roads worth traveling rarely are. Together we will embark on a campaign to not only free the church from debt, but to free our future.

FREEDOM FOR THE NEXT GENERATION

It has always been on Pastor Jim's heart to leave the church to the next generation "debt free".

That debt is the \$13 million mortgage on the church building and properties.

We are committed to our staff and pastors who have given of their lives to minister the Gospel, and it has always been our desire to be able to support, in some capacity, those who have served all their lives so they could be blessed in their latter years. In order to do this, we need to free ourselves from the \$87,000 per month mortgage payment, focus loward the next generation, while taking care of the previous generations.

FREEDOM FROM A FINANCIAL INSTITUTION

The present global economic situation drives us to fulfill our obligation to the lender early. Foreclosures on churches are higher than they have ever been in history. Lenders have become less willing to negotiate rates for loans and some banks are even facing financial troubles themselves. We cannot predict when the economy will turn around or if it will ever be like it once was, but what we can do is work to protect our legacy by paying off the \$13 million burden.

Every 5 years our loan is due in full (a balloon payment). Typically, at that time, we renegotiate the loan for another five-year term. The issue lies in the fact that our mortgage mostly covers interest, keeping us from paying principle balance indefinitely. We pay a financial institution interest amount of \$70,000 every month on average!



FREEDOM FOR MORE MINISTRIES

Imagine how much we could accomplish if we could focus what we are currently spending on our mortgage into more ministries. How much more outreach and missions work could be done with the \$87,000 a month that is currently going to a lender? What could we sow into our community and into the world for the sake of the gospel with those funds?

Additionally, we could build growing ministries such as:

- Iglesa la Roca our Spanish service
- World Missions
- The Rock Christian School to improve and build more classrooms, play areas, and sports fields so that our children can have the best education and health possible.

Beyond praying, we're asking you to consider what role God would have you play in giving toward Freedom For Our Future. Can you imagine what it would be like if The Rock had \$87,000 more a month to build into the kingdom of God? Know that God has enabled you to give more than you ever dreamed possible over three years. Your heart will expand as you became more open-handed and generous, and most of all know that you will have helped open the door for thousands of people to discover a relationship with Jesus.

Over the past 25 years, The Rock Church has been marked by people who were willing to sacrifice their resources so that others could discover the love of God just like they have. We know God hasn't given everyone the ability to give the same dollar amount, but He does call us to bring what we have. Not equal giving, but equal sacifice. Mix it with faith and be part of something bigger than yourself. Even if you've never given to God's work before, this is a good time to test the waters. Everyone can participate in some way!

Often times some sort of sacrifice is required to get to where you want to be. For us to continue to make an impact around the world it's going to take some sacrifice. It's going to take some shared shifting in priorities, in spending, and in giving. If we want to reach those around us, we need to make an opportunity for them to be reached. We need to create an experience that will change their lives. And we can do this – BUT NOT WITHOUT YOU.

STEP ONE DELIBERATE

TALK WITH GOD

First we ask that you go to God and ask that His will be done in your life. It's important that you are striving to follow the direction He has for you and that you find the doors He wants you to walk through.

The Apostle Paul told the believers, "Put aside some amount of money in relation to what you have earned and save it for this offering" (I Corinthians 16:2 (NLT). Paul is saying to prayerfully consider how much to give. Do it in advance. It should never be a last-minute or flippant practice. Paul also says "in relation to what you have earned." In other words, not all of our gifts can be equal, but our sacrifice can be. Giving is an opportunity to be an obedient Christian. We should take it seriously, and do it cheerfully.

STEP TWO DEFINE

WHAT DOES SACRIFICE LOOK LIKE FOR YOU

What changes can you make in your life that will better enable you to invest in what you believe in? How can you give in ways that will make a difference in your life? If you're excited about getting involved, but you're not sure where to start, let us help out! The truth is, there are several creative ways to contribute to our Freedom For Our Future campaign. Here are a few examples:

DEOREASE

Is there something in your daily life that you can take advantage of less frequently? By decreasing a weekly expense, regardless of what it may be, you can save a significant amount of money to contribute to Freedom For Our Future.

DELAY

Are there any plans that you might be making that involve a financial commitment? If so, prayerfully consider delaying these plans and use that extra income to contribute.

Examples: delay that remodeling project, take that vacation next winter, or wait to buy a new car.

DO MORE

Consider some creative ways you can do more is another way you can give to Freedom For Our Future. Perhaps it's been a while since you've gotten another quote on an existing service. Maybe you can do some extra comparison or bargain shopping.

Examples: Shop around for the best price on auto insurance and give the savings to Freedom For Our Future. Pay off a bill; keep giving that amount to Freedom For Our Future.

DONATE

Another way you can contribute to Freedom For Our Future is by giving assets. Giving an asset to the church and then letting the church sell it eliminates potential capital gains taxes and can increase the after-tax proceeds.

Ways you can donate: Donate stocks, real estate, bonds, assets, etc....

STEP THREE DETERMINE

DETERMINE A STARTING POINT

Freedom For Our Future is based on **"Not equal gifts, but equal sacrifice."** In other words, not all of our gifts will be the same amount, but every one of us can meaningfully invest in proportion to the resources God has given us to work with. Your three-year commitment is to be a demonstration of the definition of sacrifice that God has revealed to you.

We thought it would be helpful to explain what commitment is and is NOT.

A PLEDGE IS a heartfelt decision to get behind what The Rock is doing – and it's something you make that's between you and God.

A PLEDGE IS NOT a contract or legal agreement, it's something you make that's between you and God.

A PLEDGE IS NOT needed <u>today</u>: as you are reading this, soak it in, pray about your involvement and on May 18 - 19. Make your special commitment with the rest of the church. It's never too late, you can make a new commitment online anytime.

> NOT A ONE TIME GIFT, BUT A JOURNEY

Patrick and Jenny prayed and asked what areas they could sacrifice for their commitment.

First they decided cut back on coffee and energy drinks \$5,000/ 3 yr.



Next they canceled their phone data plans

START

They decided to downgrade or give up their TV and read the Bible more. \$2,800 / 3 yr. They cut out fast food and made healthy meals.

They paid off a credit card & kept giving that amount, back to the church.

They decided to donate their spare car to the church. \$3,000

Together they were able to give over \$25,000 Over three years.

Prayerfully come up with a three-year plan of giving that goes above and beyond your regular tithe. Remember, we are not just paying off debt; we are investing in bringing the gospel of Jesus Christ to this and future generations.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q. What is "Freedom For Our Future'

A. "Freedom For Our Future" (FFF) is a 36-month giving program with the goal of raising \$13 million. This is our opportunity to take advantage of all that the Lord has given us by increasing the influence of Christ in the lives of everyone in the world.

Q. How is this different from my tithe?

A. During this period of expansion and growth, the ministries of The Rock Church will be working harder than ever meeting the needs of people. Because of this, we ask that your "Freedom For Our Future" cash gift and faith commitment be above and beyond your tithes. This way, the vital ministries of the church will not fall behind, but keep pace with the ever-growing needs of our church, community, and world.

Q. How will I know how much to give?

A. Pray daily and allow God to open your heart and direct you about your commitment. Through prayer and personal assessment, you will know what to give. FFF is a 36 month program so you can commit to give for 36 months or a one time gift or anything inbetween. Your commitment is not binding but it does help us to determine where we are in our goal to pay off this church.

Q. How long do I give?

A. "Freedom For Our Future" is a 36-month giving program, with the first fruit on June 22 & 23. You will receive a commitment card and be asked to fill out the card with the amount you intend to give as your "First Fruit" offering and the balance of your commitment for the campaign. You may give weekly, monthly, quarterly, yearly, or in a lump sum. Most people prefer a system of regular giving; however, you should make your decision based on God's will and the best method for you.

Q. How will I designate my ongoing commitment for "Freedom For Our Future" after Commitment Weekend? A. Our offering envelopes will have an area where you can indicate what part of your offering is for "Freedom For Our Future" and what part is for regular tithes and offerings or go online.

Q. When is the commitment date?

A. The day church gets together and makes a commitment is on May 18 and 19.

On our 25th annverasary (June 23-24) we will start giving toward that commitment.

Q. Why do we need a campaign?

A. Every 5 years our loan is due in full (a balloon payment). Typically, at that time, we renegotiate the loan for another five-year term. The issue lies in the fact that our mortgage mostly covers interest, keeping us from paying principle balance indefinitely. We pay a financial institution interest to the averaged amount of \$70,000 every month!
